



Founded in 1965, Samaritan Behavioral Health, Inc. (SBHI), a subsidiary of Premier Health, provides mental health and addiction services that touch, teach, and heal. SBHI serves all ages in Southwest Ohio, including Preble, Montgomery, Miami, and Warren counties.



SBHI's Substance Abuse Services include outpatient counseling, group counseling, care coordination, peer support, medication-assisted treatment, assessment, and ambulatory detox. These services are delivered in Montgomery County. Our mental health services include, diagnostic evaluation, individual & family counseling, case management and psychiatric services. SBHI delivers these services in Warren, Montgomery, Preble and Miami Counties.



Our Preble County Office offers 24/7 crisis services. Individuals can access services by calling **(937) 456-1915** or **(866) 532-3097** or by coming into the office.



SBHI's Young Children's Assessment and Treatment Services provides early childhood mental health services on-site and in the community. This program serves children and their families from infancy to age 8.



Consumer Advocacy Model program offers mental health and substance treatment services to individuals 18 and older who are severely mentally ill and often dealing with substance abuse.



SBHI offers psychiatric evaluations and medication management at all our sites. Our providers are all psychiatrists or nurse practitioners. We also offer Medication Management Solutions to patients who qualify for medication only service, ages 6 and older.



SBHI's School Services offers mental health counseling in the school setting in Montgomery and Miami counties.
